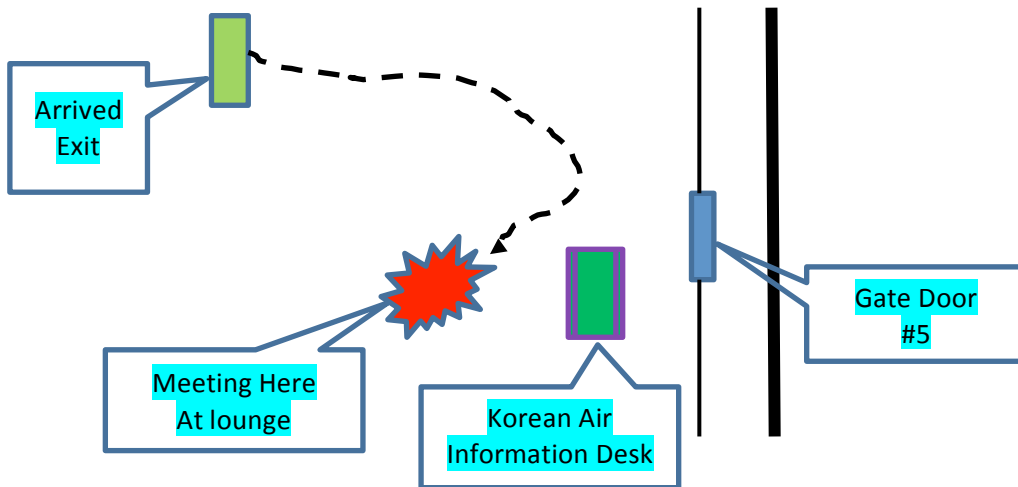

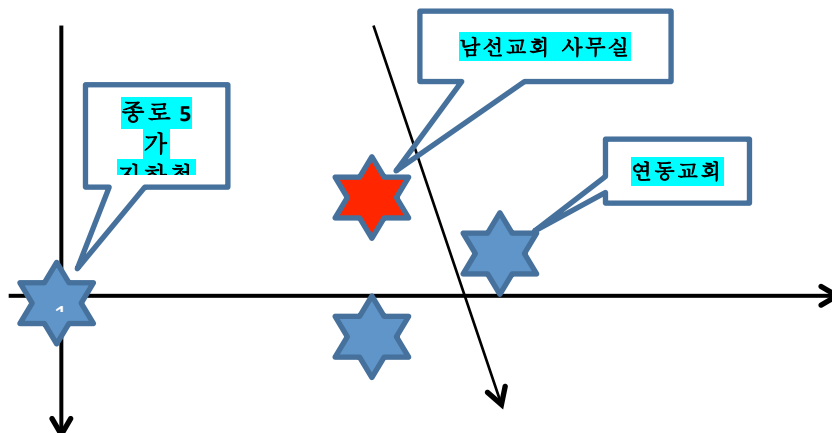
Meeting Place in Korea
